Whereas there is a need for the construction of Aggarwal Bhawan , temple of Maharaja Aggarsain, Aggarwal School and Hospital etc, we the following Trustees execute this Trust Deed today i.e. on 15th day of November, 1979.

3. Om Sharan Bansal S/o Sh. Hanuman Das.

WHEREAS the above named persons are desirous to establish a Trust for carrying out charitable purposes and as such, we with our free will create and establish the Trust In respect of an initial sum of Rs.5511/- to be contributed by each of us Rs. 50/-only and hereby grant and dedicate to the said sum in Trust to the Trustees hereinafter mentioned and they shall hold such sum and other sum/sums and property/properties that may be received from time to time in Trust for the purpose hereinafter mentioned and shall have no other interest in the property of the Trust except that of Trustees and for the administration of this Trust and for the aims and objects of this Trust.

1. That the Trust shall be known as "MAHARAJA AGGARSAIN CHARITABLE TRUST, SIRSA." The number of Trustees can be raised upto 51 and all will have equal rights.
2. That the Trustees shall hold the property vested in them by virtue of this Trust Deed and any other property that may be acquired by them hereinafter in Trust for the application of the corpus as well as income thereof for the advancement-furtherance and fulfilment of the following aims and objects :-
  - a) That after purchasing or taking land on long lease basic, to construct a Dhamashala Bhawan etc, any Place deemed fit by the trustees and to run the same for the benefit of all Persons without distinction of any caste/ creed or colour.
  - b) To start other institution or institutions for education or medical aid for the benefit of all persons.
  - c) To give donations to other institutions doing charitable works.
  - d) To grant lump sum or periodical assistance to poor students for their education or to the poor widows for their maintenance or to poor persons for medical relief, to grant recoverable loans for such purposes.
  - e) To do all other works for the advancement of the above purposes .
- 4) That the Trustees shall receive donations from the Govt. Local bodies, state organs, public or private institution and private persons for the purpose of the advancement of the above objects.

  - 10) That the first Executive committee shall consists of three persons as follows :-
    - 1. Sh. Mahabir Parshad Ganeriwala Chairman
    - 2. Sh. Suresh Kumar Minchanabadwala Secretary
    - 3. Sh. Om Sharn Bansal Cashier of the Trust .

The tenure of the first Executive Committee of the Trust shall be two years from the date of the registration of the Trust. There after every two years. The Executive Committee and its Officer bearers shall be elected by the board of the then Trustees.
